An internationally recognized expert in complex surgical oncology, he specializes in pancreatic, liver, and gastrointestinal surgery, including advanced minimally invasive techniques, including and robotic-assisted procedures. His research focuses on pancreatic cancer, gastrointestinal oncology, and digital innovations in surgery.

Before returning to Heidelberg in 2023, he held positions at leading institutions in Germany and the U.S. He is committed to advancing interdisciplinary and patient-centered surgical oncology.
